## Code of Conduct for Young People

---

Young people attending Lumos in July 2009 are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects favourably on themselves, their families, parishes and schools. You are asked to project an image of consideration, sensitivity and respect for yourself and for others during the weekend. You are also asked to show respect to adult leaders, and other participants. With this in mind, we say that you are expected:

1. Not to possess or use illegal substances (drugs), alcohol, or carry weapons of any kind.
2. To follow all schedules, rules, guidelines and emergency procedure plans of the programme and facility. This includes things such as night time quiet and mobile phone use!
3. To socialize prior to curfew in public areas. No visiting is permitted in sleeping rooms occupied by members of the opposite sex.
4. Not to put down or make fun of another person and not to hurt anyone verbally, emotionally, physically, or in any other way.
5. To refrain from using swear words and language that others may find offensive.
6. To work towards making the event a good and safe time for everyone.

7.  I do smoke  I do not smoke

If you smoke, you agree to do so with consideration to other participants, to smoke in designated areas and to uphold 'no smoking' rules when required.

I understand that I am asked not to bring valuable items (such as MP3 players) to the weekend, as neither the centre nor the RC Diocese of Northampton will take any responsibility for theft or any damage incurred.

I have read and understand the above code of conduct and commit to uphold this code during the Lumos weekend from the 17<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> July 2009.
